## Prepare the Future

The online Bachelor of Arts in Elementary Education program prepares students for rewarding careers teaching children in grades 2 through 6 . Through the online learning experience, students learn to engage children in inquiry, facilitate learning and develop curriculum. Students also learn to collect, analyze and interpret student data to inform instruction.

## Field and Clinical Experiences

This program requires extensive field experiences in South Carolina P-12 schools. High-quality, diverse school experiences are essential to an effective teacher preparation program. Through these experiences, students gain valuable knowledge and skills by observing and working with teachers, school children, administrators and parents.

The Office of Clinical Experiences will arrange all field experience, practicum and internship locations. The College of Education works to provide quality and diverse P-12 experiences throughout the program. While efforts will be made to minimize lengthy travel time to schools, students should be aware that some travel may be required to participate in these experiences.

How long does it take to complete the degree? Once admitted to the Palmetto College BA in Elementary Education program, students should expect to take two years to complete the remaining required courses and internships.

What are the requirements of the program?
The program is designed for students who have completed an associate degree or at least 30 credit hours of collegelevel coursework. Total requirements for the degree are 120 credit hours, including credits earned previously and Palmetto College courses.
