#### **Rationale for Proposed Revisions**

- USCL has proposed a revision to its two-year business degree.
- System affairs committee moves that this revision be adopted as the new AS (Business).

#### **Summary of Proposed Revisions**

- STAT 201 (an ARP approved course required for some 4-year business degrees) has been added as an option in item II.
- In item VI, the options for have been expanded to any GSS course, rather than only PSYC 101 or SOCY 101.
- The options in item VII have been simplified, requiring an AIU or GHS course, removing the three POLI options.
- One obsolete course (ITEC 240) has been deleted as an option.
