



GPA Calculator

Your grade point average (GPA) is computed on the basis of all semester hours attempted for credit, *except for* credit hours carried under the Pass-Fail or audit options. Courses in which a grade of **S, U, AUD, T, or W** was earned are not considered in computing the GPA.

The grade points earned in any course carried with a passing grade (**A, B+, B, C+, C, D+, D**) are computed by multiplying the number of semester hour credits assigned to the course by a factor determined by the grade.

A = 4; B+ = 3.5; B = 3; C+ = 2.5; C = 2; D+ = 1.5; D = 1.

The grade point average is determined by dividing the total number of semester grade points earned by the total number of semester hours attempted for credit (excepting hours carried on a Pass-Fail or audit basis).

No grade points are assigned to the symbols **F, S, U, WF, W, I, AUD, T, or NR.**

Example:

If you received the following grades:

English 101: B (3 hour class)

Math 111: C (3 hour class)

History 112: A (3 hour class)

Biology 101: B (4 hour class)

Your GPA would be: $3 \times 3 + 2 \times 3 + 4 \times 3 + 3 \times 4 = 39 / 13 = 3.0$
