



TRANSFER CREDIT GUIDE: SCHOOL OF MUSIC

If you are a South Carolina technical college student who plans to transfer to the University's College of Arts and Sciences, to pursue *a major in the School of Music*, you should consider the following courses as you schedule your technical college classes. The courses listed below will transfer to degree programs within the School of Music. This list does not include every technical college course which is available for transfer to the University of South Carolina. You are not required to take all courses listed prior to transferring. Rather, it is a guide for you and your advisors.* You should be aware that courses must be passed with a *grade of C or higher* in order to be considered for transfer credit. Students must perform a qualifying audition prior to admission to a music degree program or before registering for applied music courses. Technical College Courses

Freshman English:

1) ENG 101 and 102

History:

Select one course from: HIS 101, 102, 106, 108, 109, 201, or 202

Foreign Language:

- 1) FRE 101, 102 (equivalent to FREN 109, 110)
- 2) GER 101, 102 (equivalent to GERM 109, 110)
- 3) SPA 101, 102 (equivalent to SPAN 109, 110)

Mathematics/Analytical Reasoning:

MAT 130 or 140 *and an additional course from:*
 a. MAT 120, 122, 141, 240, or 242
 b. CPT 101
 c. PHI 105

Philosophical Reasoning:

PHI 101 or 115

Laboratory Sciences:

Two courses selected from the following:
 a. AST 101, 102
 b. BIO 101, 102, 205, 206
 c. CHM 110, 111
 d. PHS 115
 e. PHY 201, 202, 221, 222

Fine Arts:

ART 101, 108, 111, 112; THE 101, 105, 205

Social Sciences:

Select courses from: ANT 101, 202, 203; ECO 201, 210, 211; GEO 121; PSC 201, 210, 215; PSY 201, 203, 204, 205, 208, 225, 240; REL 101, 102, 103; SOC 101, 205, 210, 220

School of Music Course Requirements

Freshman English (6 hours):

1) ENGL 101 and 102 (6 hours)

History (3 hours):

Select one course from: HIST 101, 102, 105, 106, 109, 111, or 112

Foreign Language (0-9 hours):

Demonstration of proficiency in one foreign language equivalent to the minimal passing grade on the exit examination in the 122 course. Students transferring credit equivalent to USC 109 and 110 may enroll in USC 122 to complete the required sequence.

Mathematics/Analytical Reasoning (6 hours):

MATH 122 or 141 *and an additional course from:*
 a. Mathematics (at the next higher level)
 b. Computer Science
 c. Logic

Philosophical Reasoning (3 hours):

PHIL 102 or 100

Laboratory Sciences (8 hours):

Two courses selected from the following areas:
 a. Astronomy
 b. Biology
 c. Chemistry
 d. Physical Science
 e. Physics

Fine Arts (3 hours):

ARTE 101; ARTH 106; ARTS 111, 112, THEA 100

Social Sciences (6-9 hours):

Three courses from the social sciences are required for the BA degree. Two courses are required for the BM degree.



Technical College Courses

Humanities:

Two courses selected from the following:

- a. ENG 283
- b. HIS 110, 130, 131, 230, 235
- c. HSS 215

Electives:

Technical college courses normally transfer as freshman or sophomore level courses, not as major courses.

- ART 105
- MAT 110, 11
- PSY 230, 231, 240
- SPC 205, 210, 215

School of Music Course Requirements

Humanities (6 hours):

Two courses selected from the following:

- a. ENGL 200
- b. HIST 100, 200; AFRO 201, 202
- c. RELG 111

Electives (varies):

The number of electives required for the BA and BM degrees varies.

- MATH 111, 112
- ELEC 100
- PSYC 100
- SPCH 140, 100
