

UNIV 101 Surveys on the Career Center General Presentation

Survey 1 (Career Center Form)

The survey was sent to UNIV 101 students who attended a Career Center presentation between October 3 and November 4, 2005. Surveys were emailed to 998 students. 235 students responded for a response rate of 24%.

The survey used a 5-point Likert scale with 5 being Strongly Agree and 1 being Strongly Disagree.
