## Graduate Assistantship in Clarinet

### ***Responsibilities***

The *Clarinet Graduate Assistant* assists with studio instruction for nonmusic majors and lower-division music students and the secondary clarinet class. Responsibilities require up to 18 hours per week, and the nine-month stipend ranges from \$5,700 to \$6,300 (tuition abatements and compensation for performance in ensemble may boost the value of the position above \$27,000 per year).
