

Graduate Assistantship in Trumpet

Responsibilities

The *Trumpet Graduate Assistant* performs with the Faculty Brass Quintet and provides studio instruction for non-music majors and lower-division music students. Responsibilities may require up to 18 hours per week, and the nine-month stipend ranges to \$6,300 (tuition abatements may boost the value of the position to \$20,000). Assistantships in *music theory*, *music appreciation*, and *facilities management* may also be available to qualified applicants.
