Methodology for Emergency Financial Aid Grants Under Section 314(a)(1) of the ARP Act

USCB has been working with the U.S. Department of Education guidelines and directions to implement a distribution plan for the U.S. Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (ARP) Act funding to our students. The purpose of the ARP Act is to provide cash grants to eligible students for expenses related to disruptions to their educations, due to the COVID-19 outbreak.

Who is eligible?

- All USCB students who are eligible to receive any type of Federal Title IV Financial Aid including Pell Grant, Direct Loan, Parent Plus Loan or Supplemental Grant.

How much will an eligible student receive?

- Qualifying USCB students will receive ARP Act funding in amounts ranging from \$125 to \$1,000 based on the level of Title IV aid for which you qualified in the Spring 2020 term, and based on whether you were full-time (at least 12 hours) or less than full-time (11 hours or less).

When will I receive my ARP grant funds?

- Students who are already qualified to receive a ARP grant will receive an automated email soon, instructing them to login to their SSC account to view a new award. Once a student logs into their SSC account and accepts their ARP grant award, the process will be initiated to disburse a check to the student's home address or to their bank account if they have set up direct deposit with USCB.
