Methodology for Emergency Financial Aid Grants Under Section 314(a)(1) of the ARP Act

- Award \$3,300 to each Fall 2021 Pell Grant Recipient currently enrolled.
- Award \$2,200 to each Fall 2020/21 non-Pell Grant Recipient currently enrolled with an EFC less than 10,000
- Award \$1,100 to each remaining student currently enrolled for Fall 2021.
- Exclude Dual Enrolled

The award notice sent to each will explain the purpose of the HEERF funds awarded to them and the process by which they can accept or decline them.

Awards will be made to students via the already-established aid awarding process. These awards will be refunded regardless of any balance on the students' account, per statute. Refunds will be sent via direct deposit or paper check, depending upon the student's already-chosen method with the Bursar's Office. Students will have the option to sign a consent to pay any current balance.
