Subject: Parking Deduction and Pre-Tax Repeal

Parking deductions are set to be reinstated beginning with the **August 31, 2020** payroll check. Along with the reinstatement, parking permit fees will also return to a pre-tax deduction.

The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017 passage affecting the classification of the pre-tax parking fringe benefit has been **repealed**. Accordingly, effective **August 16, 2020**, all parking deductions for Columbia campus employees will transition back from post-tax to pre-tax.

Parking permit fees will now be a pre-tax item. Employees that are currently utilizing the payroll deduction option will be transitioned back to pre-tax payroll deductions. The deduction amount will remain the same and employees do not need to take any action. Employees will see this change on their August 31st payroll check.
