- 2. unITe Integrated Help Desk proposal
 - Goal of unITe: a collaborative effort of colleges and departments across the university system with a common purpose of enhancing the efficiency and effectiveness of the collective IT function at all campuses.
 - Members of the ITEB reviewed the Integrated Help Desk initiative charter and voted unanimously to approve. A pilot program will begin in the College of Social Work in the Fall.
