

A Hot Work Permit is required for any work that uses a flame, creates a spark, or produces smoke. <u>Requests for a permit shall be received by USC Fire Safety at least 24 hours prior to the start of work.</u> A copy of the approved permit must be kept on site at all times when hot work is being performed. The hot work permit is not valid unless approved by USC Fire Safety.
