#### **Compliance**

The Off-Site Reaffirmation Committee found support for the institution's case for compliance.

The Libraries provides adequate access and user privileges. Additionally, the Libraries provides its faculty and students with access to regular and timely library and learning resources instruction. Access and privileges are provided both online and in person. The Libraries maintain a plethora of electronic tools to manage and provide access to its collections and services. Its staff provides knowledgeable support for and access to its collections and services. The main and branch libraries maintain adequate hours for student and faculty access. Online access is available 24/7. Circulation duration for physical materials is adequate. The Libraries provide instruction through its "Liaison" program, whereby a librarian is assigned to every academic unit to provide formal and informal instruction as well as to provide overall research and reference support. The instructional services are in line with the national standard for library instruction and outreach as outlined in the Association of College and Research Libraries Framework for Information Literacy in Higher Education. Digital communication and outreach are provided through online newsletters and other tools to provide current information on library resources. The Libraries is a partner in important campus outreach programs, such as "University 101," South Carolina's first year experience program.
