Accepted Foreign Credential Evaluators

All transcripts submitted from foreign universities or schools must be evaluated for equivalency to United States accredited coursework by a university-accepted foreign credential evaluator. The transcript and other applicable academic records should be accompanied by a notarized translation, if not in English. If a transcript is not available, the foreign credential evaluator may evaluate the instructor's foreign credentials for equivalence to a U.S. degree.

Evaluations from the following agencies are accepted at the University of South Carolina:
