The University of South Carolina Columbia is closing the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree program in Russian because it is being consolidated with several other programs into a single B.A. degree in Languages, Literatures, and Cultures. Students who are currently enrolled in the program have been informed of its closure and were given the option of completing their degree as planned, or transferring to the Russian concentration within the newly created B.A. program. Students will not face disruption or additional expense with either option. Faculty members who are teaching in the Russian program will now teach the required courses for the Russian concentration within the Languages, Literatures, and Cultures program, and will not be adversely impacted by the closure.

**The Board of Trustees of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges approves the closure of the Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) degree program in Russian.**
