Close Family Emerging Leaders Program

For more than 45 years, the Close Family Emerging Leaders Program (CFELP) has provided students with the tools to develop their leadership skills and prepare themselves for leadership roles on campus. No matter what level of leadership experience you have, CFELP will help provide a foundation focused around your personal strengths and authentic self.

LeaderShape Institute

The LeaderShape Institute is an intensive four-day retreat that provides participants the opportunity for self-discovery, self-reflection and feedback in a community of approximately 60 peers. Not a typical leadership retreat, the Institute is grounded in helping individuals identify the values they hold that lead to making a difference in the communities around them.

Peer Leadership

Peer leaders are student volunteers who give back to their communities while growing as leaders, teammates, mentors, and changemakers. At the University of South Carolina, peer leadership is more than a role – it's a commitment to service, mentorship, and building a stronger Gamecock campus and community.
