Minority Student Research

During the summer of 2016, 59 under-represented minority students conducted research with USC faculty members.

USC hosted summer research students participating in the SC Alliance for Minority Participation program, CCCR Summer Minority Undergraduate Research Program, TRiO Ronald E. McNair Post-Baccalaureate Achievement program, SC Advancing Diversity in Aging Research Program and two NSF Research Experiences for Undergraduates programs.

35 USC faculty received support from the SMART (Support for Minority Advancement in Research Training) program for mentoring under-represented minority students in 2016.

VPR Office sponsored **Research: Next Steps to Success**, a professional development workshop series with special focus on preparing students to apply for graduate school; workshops featured invited faculty and graduate student panelists.

The Office of Research sponsored and organized the USC Summer Research Symposium. This university-wide poster session featured 89 undergraduate students from 39 colleges and universities who conducted research at USC this summer.
