Call to Order - Chris Burkett, President

Guest Speakers –

Jeremiah Donati, USC Athletics Director

USC Athletics Director shared updates from university athletics.

- Starting July 2025, athletics has to distribute \$20.5 million in revenue directly to USC student-athletes. This number will increase by 4% annually.
- In addition to the revenue share, student-athletes can continue to earn additional revenue through traditional third-party NIL deals.
- Williams-Brice stadium renovations are forthcoming. Bathrooms, concessions, seating, premiere suites and infrastructure are all being targeted with a 350 million budget.
 - o Huge emphasis on enhancing the student experience at football games
- Continue to work and build the athletics brand to be consistent across the university.
- New partnership with Nike coming July 2026.

Budget Review – *Manda Tuk, Staff Senate Treasurer*

- Treasurer Tuk shared a historic review of Staff Senate operations and revenues
- We have 15K in our Foundations account
- Requesting another 41K for the 2026 Staff Appreciation Day

Membership – Katie Annan

- A <u>survey for current senators is available</u> to gather information about your readiness to serve. We will use this information to inform our decisions moving forward.

Communications – Emily Miles & Thom Harman

- Working to enhance communications across university staff. Analyzing previous survey results on communication within units.

Staff Policy and Well-being – Kelsey Chambers & Caroline Hulett

- HR Transformation Updates: About to hire 3 new HR business partners for three groups of areas (ex: parking, facilities, and similar areas are grouped). The Goal is not to replace HR directors but to improve overall HR access for all, consistency, and ability to build career pipelines
 - Pay Band Alignment Moving to SC's state pay bands by Feb. 01, 2026 and continue with market structure. Will use state's pay 4 structures: General, Law Enforcement, IT, and Clinical- All that do not fit the last three will fit into General. An advisory group will be formed to assist with the transition
 - Data from those who separated from USC as of July 01 to be reported at the end of the first quarter (end of September) as it relates to Return to Campus
 - Shared updates on wellness spaces for faculty and staff
 - Met with Jim Walcyzk (Campus Recreation), Amanda Castles (Employee Well-Being), and John Brey (NexPlay) to discuss topic in spring 2025
 - Campus Recreation & Employee Well-Being agreed to take lead on project, with the Staff Policy & Well-Being Committee offering input, advocacy, and support; will likely employ NexPlay to design and transform spaces
 - August 2025 Update Campus Recreation is working on a renovation study, which includes identifying space in Blatt or Wellness & Fitness Center; we will wait for this step to be completed to move forward

Professional Development – Jalen Fuller & Brett Williams

- Met with Kim Pruitt, Director of Organizational and Professional Development. Discussed OPD's role at the University, how they plan to address professional development for our employees, and how they would like to interact with the Staff Senate committee. Working on next steps.
- Met with the Scholarship and Fundraising Committee and the Executive Committee to discuss a collaboration between the PD and SF committees. Findings from this meeting will be discussed at our next committee meeting on Tuesday, September 16th via Teams at 2:00PM.
