

BEHAVIORS TO REFER TO THE CARE TEAM



PSYCHOLOGICAL INDICATORS

- Excessive emotional responses to events
- Sudden irritability or abrasiveness
- Apathy
- Reports of concern from peers
- Disclosure of self-harming behaviors or suicidal ideation
- Delusions and paranoia
- Unusual behavior



PHYSICAL INDICATORS

- Visible changes in physical appearance (decline in hygiene, rapid weight change, or being disheveled)
- Constant lack of energy or fatigue
- Impaired speech
- Disjointed thoughts
- Noticeable intoxication or hangover



ACADEMIC INDICATORS

- Sudden change in attendance or performance
- Rapid decline in work quality or grades
- Repeated requests for extensions
- Disruptive behavior in a classroom
- Assignments that indicate extreme distress, despair, hopelessness, or rage
- Bizarre or unusual content in assignments




SAFETY RISK INDICATORS


- Threats of violence or harm to self or others
- Sudden anger or hostility
- Persistent unwanted contact or harassment
- Assignments disclosing concerning behaviors
- Posts/discussion about revenge/feeling persecuted
- Physical violence
