Lottery Tuition Assistance Program**

Requirements:

- You must be a South Carolina Resident
- You must be a U.S. Citizen or Eligible Non-Citizen
- You must enroll in two classes (6 hours, in the same semester)
- You must complete the Dual Enrollment forms with your School Counselor (School form & Student form)
- You must submit the USCL Online Admissions Application for Dual Enrollment (\$10 application fee):
 - * Online application can be accessed at sc.edu/lancaster, click apply, and Step 2 (Online Application Here).
- You must have a 3.0 High School GPA to be admitted to Dual Enrollment

STOP THE LIFE CLOCK!!

- Lottery Tuition Assistance for Dual Enrollment does NOT Start the LIFE Clock!
- College students get 4 years of LIFE Scholarship eligibility after high school graduation.
- Normally this starts the day you start college classes. HOWEVER, Dual Enrollment Classes do NOT start your LIFE clock!
- Receiving SC Lottery Tuition Assistance WILL NOT reduce your LIFE eligibility.
- Colleges will look at your High School GPA to determine your initial LIFE eligibility, not your College GPA.
- Your grades from Dual Enrollment will affect your eligibility starting your 2nd year of college.
