- Your U.S. passport.
- Certificate of Naturalization (N-550 or N-570) issued by USCIS.
- Certificate of Citizenship (N-560 or N-561) issued by USCIS to individuals who derive U.S. citizenship through a parent.
- Other documentation you received from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) such as Form FS-240, FS545, or DS1350.

U.S. Permanent Resident or Other Eligible Noncitizen Documentation
