- \*ENGL 101 & 102 – English Composition and Literature

- \*SOCY 101 – Sociology
- \*+STAT 201 – Statistics
- \*+PSYC 420 – Survey of Developmental Psychology

**Completion of other required courses for UofSC Aiken’s Bachelor’s Degree:**

- BIOL 250 & 250L – Microbiology
- HIST 101 or 102 – History
- POLI 201 – American Government
- SPCH 140 – Public Communication
- Non-Western Humanities (RELG120)
- 2 Humanities courses

**Completion of Foreign Language course to earn an Associate’s Degree from UofSC Union is strongly encouraged.**

**Prior to application, students need to:**

- Complete 30 semester hours
- Earn a grade of 2.0 or better in each of these courses
- Achieve a minimum GPA of 3.0 for core courses

**General education requirements:**

- ICE: 16 are required for all traditional students
- Writing Intensive Courses: 3 are required for graduation; 5 are available within the nursing curriculum
- WPP: complete prior to beginning the final semester in the nursing program

**\*+Pre-application requisite hours:**

- PSYC 420 *or* STAT 201 may be counted toward the 30 pre-application semester hours; however,
- PSYC 420 and STAT 201 must be completed prior to beginning the BSN program
