PURPOSE

The university requires that health care and/or child facilities hold at least twelve (12) fire drills each year. Residential occupancies shall hold at least two (2) fire drills per semester. Business occupancies, with fire alarms, (classroom, laboratories etc.) will have at least one (1) fire drill each year.

PROCEDURES

A. Health or Child Care Facilities

- 1. Each health or child care facility will conduct at least twelve (12) fire drills each year.
- 2. Drills wil be scheduled by Fire Safety in cooperation with the office manager.
- 3. The drills will be a joint operation between Fire Safety and supervisory persons.
- 4. Fire Safety has the responsibility for required reports and notification of other agencies as required.

B. Residence Halls

- 1. Each residence hall will conduct at least two (2) fire drills per semester.
- 2. Drills will be scheduled by Fire Safety in cooperation with Residential Life Department.
- 3. The drills will be a joint operation between Fire Safety and housing professional staff.
- 4. Fire Safety has the responsibility for required reports and notification of other agencies as required.
