I. Policy

The Blatt Physical Education Center and Strom Thurmond Wellness and Fitness Center exist in order to provide appropriate academic and recreational facilities for use by the university's students, faculty, staff, and guests. A wholesome atmosphere is of a major concern to the users and management of both facilities. Use of the centers is a privilege, not a right. Any person using the centers who exhibits conduct of a physical or verbal nature unbecoming of a member of the university community (reference the Carolinian Creed at <https://www.sa.sc.edu/creed/>) may be asked to leave the center. Incidents of a serious nature, as determined by the director of Campus Recreation, may result in the offending person losing their center privileges for a specified amount of time or on a permanent basis.
