The university reserves the right to take appropriate action to provide a secure environment for all present on the campus during such an appearance. The university will strive to minimize any inconvenience to students, faculty, and staff. Advance notice of schedule or operational changes and event details will be distributed in advance of the event, as that information is collected.
