Candidates for these positions are often part of dual career couples. A candidate's final decision to accept or reject an offer of employment is increasingly influenced by the University's ability to identify appropriate employment for the candidate's spouse or partner. Policy <u>ACAF 1.61 Faculty Dual Career Accommodation</u> is designed to assist department chairs, program directors, and other administrators attempting to explore a spouse/partner hire.
