## ART EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS 2024 – 2025

Guidelines for the Mary Carter Grant Memorial Scholarship and the Robyn Chartier Crotwell Scholarship

**For incoming freshmen and transfer students,** you must be admitted and have a declared major in Art Education at USC.

The following documents must be uploaded to the online scholarship application form.

- 1. An unofficial high school or college transcript.
- 2. Ten (10) digital images of representative artworks that have been completed by you in the past two years. Include the following information in the name of your artwork files: title, medium, dimensions and date of completion. You may also include a link to your online portfolio site.
- 3. A 3-page double spaced paper in which you: Describe the unique qualities of your art teacher(s) and art experiences that inspired you to become an art teacher.
- 4. A letter of recommendation from one of your high school or college art teachers.

**For continuing USC students,** you must be a declared Art Education major with a GPA of 3.0 or higher for all classes at USC.

- 1. An unofficial transcript of your college record with your application. This can be downloaded from Self Service Carolina (my.sc.edu).
- 2. Ten (10) digital images of representative artworks that have been completed by you in the past two years. Include the following information in the name of your artwork files: title, medium, dimensions and date of completion. You may also include a link to your online portfolio site.
- 3. A 3-page double spaced paper in which you respond to this question: What kind of diversity should good art teachers offer children and youth in pre-K thru 12<sup>th</sup> grade?
- 4. A letter of recommendation from one of your Art Education professors at UC.

## Guidelines for the Ethel Sobel Brody Scholarship

**For continuing USC students,** you must be a declared Art Education major with a GPA of 3.0 or higher for all classes at USC. Applicants should have less than 90 credit hours completed at the time of application. Please note that applicants to the Ethel S. Brody Scholarship will be interviewed by Art Education faculty.

- 1. An unofficial transcript of your college record with your application. This can be downloaded from Self Service Carolina (<a href="mailto:my.sc.edu">my.sc.edu</a>).
- 2. Ten (10) digital images of representative artworks that have been completed by you in the past two years. Include the following information in the name of your artwork files: title, medium, dimensions and date of completion. You may also include a link to your online portfolio site.
