College of Hospitality, Retail & Sport Management Interdisciplinary Faculty Grant Program (IFG)

HRSM faculty at any rank may apply for up to \$10,000 assistance to conduct an interdisciplinary research project that will address an important issue or need. The project is expected to lead to a publication in a high quality journal. Faculty mentor and mentee collaborations are highly encouraged. A progress report and a final report on the project is due to the Associate Dean of Faculty and Operations by dates indicated below. Extensions must be requested by March 1 of each year. The progress report will detail progress to date, including any preliminary results stemming from the award.

The final report should be written in publishable paper format (15-20 pages or up to 9,000 words) following a typical journal manuscript outline in one's professional field with a brief introduction, statement of significance, purpose statement, literature review, method, results and conclusion.

Deadlines and Due dates:

Annual Cycle

Application submission: First Monday in March

Notification of support by: April Progress Report due by: December

Final Report due by: April 1st following year

Funds are to be used only to support interdisciplinary and unfunded research that will address an important issue and fill the gap in relevant literature. Faculty members receiving these funds cannot be paid salary from the funds. If travel is justified based upon the nature of the research, a portion of the funds may be used for travel. Once awarded, the same faculty cannot be eligible for five years. Cost efficient applications are encouraged.

In association with the Faculty Research and Grants Committee, the Associate Dean for Faculty and Operations will review and select proposals that advance the mission of the college for funding.

Faculty members who have resigned their positions effective during or at the end of the current academic year are not eligible for this award. Faculty must be actively employed in the College of HRSM in the academic year following the grant award period/semester or they must repay the grant prior to leaving USC.
