



# Child Death Investigations: The Basics

**Who should attend:** DSS investigators, law enforcement officers, coroners or their designees, prosecutors, child abuse medical professionals, DSS Child Fatality Program Manager

**Overview:** This training will focus on the basics of child death investigations. Topics will include causes and manners of deaths; response and review of a child death, to include an overview of the Child Death Investigation Task Force; proper procedures for conducting reenactments; interviewing parents/caregivers and witnesses; documenting investigative findings; multi-disciplinary coordination of investigations; and the appropriate roles of DSS and law enforcement. Applicable definitions from the S.C. Children's Code and criminal statutes will also be addressed.

All in-person trainings will be held at the Children's Law Center's Training Center, 1114 Pickens Street, Columbia, SC 29208. A link to the virtual training being offered on 2/4/25 will be sent to registrants near the date of the training.
