

# Training of Trainers: Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect

**Who should attend:** Professionals who are interested in conducting mandated reporter training within their organization. It is a requirement that you have attended a basic Mandated Reporter training with the Children's Law Center to attend this training.

**Overview:** In this training, participants will learn how to deliver the Children's Law Center's *Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect (Mandated Reporter) Training* and answer frequently asked questions about mandated reporting. Participants will be required to attend the full training, pass a quiz, and return at a later date to conduct a presentation. Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive a certificate of completion and may then conduct the Center's *Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect Training* to employees within their organizations.
