

# Recognizing & Reporting Child Abuse & Neglect Webinar

## Overview:

This webinar is designed for mandated reporters of child abuse and neglect, and professionals who have frequent contact with children, who play a key role in protecting children by identifying possible maltreatment and reporting it to the agencies responsible for investigation and intervention.

Participants will learn to:

- Identify mandated reporters according to South Carolina law
- Describe statutory requirements and protections
- Identify the role and responsibilities of mandated reporters
- Recognize signs of possible abuse and neglect
- Describe when to make a report of child abuse and neglect
