**C= satisfies Children's Law Concentration requirement**

**E = satisfies experiential course graduation requirement**

**P = satisfies perspective course graduation requirement**

**E or W = satisfies the experiential course graduation requirement OR writing requirement, but not both**

**W = satisfies writing requirement**

**W(3) = students may elect to receive 3 hours credit by satisfying the writing requirement**

1. A three-credit-hour course that meets for two hours a week.
2. Enrollment by client-contact lottery. Attendance at the first class session is mandatory. Professional Responsibility or Problems in Professional Responsibility is a prerequisite or co-requisite. **Students may not enroll in a clinical course or externship in the same semester. Also, students may not enroll in a clinical course and ICN in the same semester.**
3. Students may elect to satisfy the writing requirement with permission of the instructor.
4. Either Professional Responsibility or Problems in Professional Responsibility is a prerequisite.
5. Problems in Professional Responsibility is a prerequisite or co-requisite. Also note that Professional Responsibility satisfies the prerequisite requirement.
6. Required for graduation and subject to block scheduling.
7. Rising 2Ls have registration priority.
8. Enrollment limited to third-year students. December graduates are eligible in the spring semester of their second year.
9. Completion of this course or Professional Responsibility with a grade of "C" or better is required for graduation. Students may not have also taken Professional Responsibility.
10. Evidence is a prerequisite.
11. Students are limited to 2 externships. Externship will require 8-10 hours of field work each week outside of the School of Law. **Students may not enroll in an externship and clinical course in the same semester.**
12. This course will meet during the fall and spring semesters. Students will receive a grade at the end of the spring semester. Students are limited to taking one reading group course per academic year, for a maximum of two (2) reading groups. Hardship petitions will not be granted for these courses.
13. Income Tax is a prerequisite.
14. A six-credit-hour course that meets for four hours a week.
15. RESERVE
16. Wills, Trusts and Estates is a prerequisite.
17. Business Associations is a prerequisite.
18. Graded on a pass/fail basis only.
19. Criminal Procedure is a prerequisite.
20. Course listed as a perspective course starting in fall 2018. Course is not considered a perspective course in prior semesters.
21. Reserve
22. Evidence is a co/pre-requisite.
23. Trial Advocacy is a pre-requisite
24. A three-credit hour course that meets for two hours a week with one hour of simulations.
