COURSE NOTES

**C= satisfies Children's Law Concentration requirement**

**E = satisfies experiential course graduation requirement**

**E or W = satisfies the experiential course graduation requirement OR writing requirement, but not both**

**P = satisfies perspective course graduation requirement**

**W = satisfies writing requirement**

**W(3) = students may elect to receive 3 hours credit by satisfying the writing requirement**

1. A three-credit-hour course that meets for two hours a week.
2. Enrollment by client-contact lottery. Attendance at the first class session is mandatory. Professional Responsibility or Problems in Professional Responsibility is a prerequisite or co-requisite. **Students may not enroll in a clinical course and capstone course or externship in the same semester. Students may not enroll in a clinical course or ICN in the same semester.**
3. Problems in Professional Responsibility is a prerequisite or co-requisite. Also note that Professional Responsibility satisfies the prerequisite requirement.
4. Either Professional Responsibility or Problems in Professional Responsibility is a prerequisite.
5. RESERVE
6. Required for graduation and subject to block scheduling.
7. 2Ls have registration priority.
8. Enrollment limited to third-year students. December graduates are eligible in the spring semester of their second year.
9. Completion of this course or Professional Responsibility with a grade of "C" or better is required for graduation. Students may not have also taken Professional Responsibility.
10. Evidence is a prerequisite.
11. Students are limited to 2 externships. **Students may not enroll in an externship and clinical course or Capstone course in the same semester.**
12. Income Tax is a prerequisite.
13. Trial Advocacy is a prerequisite.
14. Business Associations is a prerequisite.
15. Graded on a pass/fail basis only.
16. Preference will be given to 2L members of the Moot Court Board.
17. Enrollment is by lottery. **Students may not enroll in a capstone course and an externship or ICN in the same semester. With permission of the Associate Dean for Academic Affairs, a student may enroll in a capstone course if the student took a clinic course in the fall.**
18. Real Estate Transactions I is a prerequisite.
19. Family Law is a pre-requisite.
20. Legislative Process is strongly recommended before applying for the Legislative externship.
21. Professional Responsibility or Problems in Professional Responsibility and Evidence are not required but preferred.
22. Corporate Tax or Partnership Tax is a pre/co-requisite
23. The prerequisite for the course is one of the following: Coastal Law, Environmental Law, Administrative Law, or Water Law. Preferential consideration will be given to students who have taken one of the prerequisites, but others are encouraged to apply.

24. A three-credit hour course that meets for two hours a week with one hour of simulations.
25. Income Tax is a co or pre-requisite.
26. Evidence is a co/pre-requisite.
27. Preference will be given to 2L members of the Mock Trial Team. Evidence may be taken as a co-requisite for this section of Trial Advocacy only.
28. RESERVE
29. Externship will require 8-15 hours of field work each week outside of the School of Law.
30. Partnership Tax is strongly recommended, but not required.
31. A six-credit-hour course that meets for four hours a week.
32. Wills, Trusts and Estates is a prerequisite.
33. Criminal Procedure is a prerequisite.
34. Class will meet for 7 weeks.
35. Students may not enroll in ICN and a clinical course or capstone course in the same semester.
