Policy Statement

It is the policy of USC School of Medicine Greenville to select students who have achieved academic excellence, bring diversity to the learning environment and demonstrate a genuine commitment to becoming a physician.

Reason for Policy

The mission of the USC School of Medicine Greenville is to prepare physicians committed to improving the health and wellness of families and the diverse communities in which they will serve. The Admissions Committee has therefore implemented procedures to select, matriculate and successfully graduate competent, respectful, compassionate physicians dedicated to providing culturally sensitive, interprofessional patient care.

Procedures

Procedures for the selection of students and the associated responsibilities of Committee members are outlined in the USC School of Medicine Greenville Admissions Evaluation Committee Manual. Each Committee member must attend an annual training session and sign documentation confirming your understanding of, and agreement with, the conflict of interest policy and guidelines for conducting the interview as published in the Admissions Evaluation Committee Manual.

Adherence to this policy will be tracked by the Director for Admissions.

Committee members who fail to adhere to this policy will be removed from the Admissions Committee.
