Scope

University of South Carolina (USC) School of Medicine Greenville faculty, staff, and students

Policy Statement

Web and video conferencing services are provided by the USC School of Medicine Greenville, Integrated Technology (IT) department. The primary platforms available for use are Webex and Microsoft Teams. This policy applies to those platforms and any others that are provided and/or supported by the Integrated Technology department.

Services to be provided include:

- Secure web and video conferencing and telepresence.
- Pre-scheduled conference setup and support.
- Password protected meetings.
- Permanent personal Webex rooms, which are always open and do not require prescheduling of conferences.
- Meeting recording and secure streaming playback.

Acceptable Usage:

- Use of video conferencing is for the purpose of university business only.
- User will not use or present any content that is in violation of state or federal laws or USC policies.
- When recording, it is the responsibility of the user to make all attendees aware in advance of any conference being recorded.
- Inclusion and sharing of Protected Health Information (PHI) must adhere to all HIPAA policies and guidelines.
- User must obtain authorization from appropriate parties prior to including, recording, or sharing any content containing sensitive information (e.g. protected health information (PHI), intellectual property, copyright material).
- Any use of this service is the responsibility of the user. IT will not assume responsibility for the misuse of content.

- User agrees to comply with all applicable USC security policies and procedures.
- IT will not assume responsibility for content that is reported or discovered to be in violation of any aforementioned policies or laws. Any recorded content will be removed pending review, and appropriate action taken if necessary.

Reason for Policy

The purpose of this policy is to govern the use of video conferencing services. It is in place to ensure compliance with all applicable University of South Carolina security policies and standards.
