

Clinical Experiences and other Check List Items for M3 Required Clerkships

All patient encounters must be entered in Oasis. All requirements must be met prior to completion of the clerkship.

EMED G710 Emergency Medicine Clerkship (M3)

1. Attend mid-rotation feedback
2. Perform basic ECG interpretation
3. Perform basic chest xray interpretation
4. Perform a point-of-care ultrasound
5. Write (and submit for feedback) two Emergency Department notes
6. Write discharge instructions (2)
7. Observe a FAVOR consult
8. Place and save orders in the EMR (5)
9. Perform calling another service for a consultation or admission
10. Perform IV insertion
11. Perform placement of a patient on cardiac monitor
12. Assist with ambulating a patient
13. Assist with stabilization of a critically ill patient
14. Assist evaluation of a patient with chest pain
15. Assist evaluation of a patient with abdominal pain
16. Assist evaluation of a patient with shortness of breath
17. Assist evaluation of a patient with a neurologic complaint (ie stroke, headache, AMS)
18. Assist evaluation of a patient with fever or other infectious symptoms
19. Assist evaluation of a patient with traumatic or orthopedic injury

FPMD G700 Family Medicine Clerkship (M3)

1. Perform #5 adult acute care outpatient visits (undifferentiated new problems).
2. Perform #5 adult chronic care outpatient visits (chronic disease management).
3. Perform #2 adult wellness visits on female patients.
4. Perform #2 adult wellness visits on male patients.
5. Perform #1 nursing home visit.
6. Perform #1 depression screening using a patient health questionnaire 9 question survey (PHQ9).
7. Perform #5 exercise counseling and complete an exercise prescription.
8. Provide #5 dietary counseling.
9. Provide #5 behavioral change counseling using principles of the trans-theoretical model and motivational interviewing.
10. Perform #1 EKG interpretation with an attending or resident.
11. Perform a musculoskeletal joint examination on a patient (#1 each- shoulder, knee, low back).
12. Perform #5 patient vaccine needs assessments using the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) vaccine mobile application to determine appropriate vaccines for a patient.
13. Perform #5 patient prevention needs assessments using the United States Preventative Services Task Force (USPSTF) mobile application- electronic preventative service selector (EPSS) to determine appropriate screening recommendations.
14. Perform #1 fracture risk assessment using the World Health Organization fracture risk assessment tool (FRAX) score.
15. Perform #1 patient interview to assess psychosocial barriers to health.
16. Perform #6 other patient encounters
17. Participate in Mid-Point feedback with the Clerkship Director

MEDI G700 Internal Medicine Clerkship (M3)

1. Perform Basic Electrocardiographic Interpretation- inpatient or outpatient
2. Perform patient care through the continuum– admit, monitor, discharge, phone contact, follow-up appt, barriers, etc.
3. Perform an observed history and physical examination – inpatient or outpatient
4. Assist in the evaluation of Congestive Heart Failure and/or Coronary Artery Disease - inpatient or outpatient
5. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with Diabetes- inpatient or outpatient
6. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with Dyspnea- inpatient or outpatient
7. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with fever/infection - inpatient or outpatient
8. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with Musculoskeletal pain - inpatient or outpatient
9. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with anemia- inpatient or outpatient
10. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with abdominal pain and/or GI bleed- inpatient or outpatient

22. Perform 8 complete history and physical examinations (8 Total)
23. Attend Mid-point feedback session
24. Give evidence-based case presentation to colleagues
25. Recommended Encounters (not required)
 - Observe an Endoscopic procedure - inpatient or outpatient
 - Observe cardiac catheterization – inpatient
 - Observe or assist in Cardiac Resuscitation (Code) utilizing basic cardiac life support (BCLS) skills-inpt or outpatient
 - Perform a Lumbar Puncture – inpatient or ED
 - Perform a microscopic examination of peripheral blood smear – inpatient
 - Perform placement of a Central Venous line – inpatient or ED

OBGY G700 Obstetrics and Gynecology Clerkship (M3)

1. Assist a complicated OB evaluation (1)
2. (diabetes, preeclampsia, third trimester bleeding, preterm labor, PPRM) – inpatient or outpatient
3. Assist a complicated OB evaluation (2)
4. (diabetes, preeclampsia, third trimester bleeding, preterm labor, PPRM) – inpatient or outpatient

PEDI G700 Pediatrics Clerkship (M3)

1. Calculate and write 2 orders for parenteral fluid administration (Inpatient)
2. Calculate and write 2 orders for a medication using weight-based dosing (Inpatient or Outpatient)
3. Provide appropriate immunization recommendations and counseling (Outpatient)
4. Give pediatric patient a vaccine (Outpatient)
5. Interpret a pediatric chest x ray (Inpatient or Outpatient)
6. Perform a directly observed history and physical: <12 m/o(Inpatient or Outpatient)
7. Perform a directly observed history and physical: 1-4 y/o (Inpatient or Outpatient)

8. Perform a directly observed history and physical: 5-11 y/o (Inpatient or Outpatient)
9. Perform a directly observed history and physical: Adolescent (Inpatient or Outpatient)
10. Perform a patient interview utilizing an interpreter (Inpatient or Outpatient)
11. Perform a well child visit and caregiver counseling: age 3-10 years (Outpatient)
12. Perform an adolescent well visit and counseling: age 11-21 years (Outpatient)
13. Perform an evaluation on a child with an acute presentation of fever (Inpatient or Outpatient)
14. Perform an evaluation on a child or adolescent with a rash (Inpatient or Outpatient)
15. Perform an evaluation on a child or adolescent with vomiting, diarrhea, or abdominal pain (Inpatient or Outpatient)
16. Perform an evaluation on a child or adolescent with CNS dysfunction such as seizure, altered mental status, etc. (Inpatient or Outpatient)
17. Perform an evaluation of a child or adolescent with obesity or failure to thrive (Inpatient or Outpatient)
18. Perform an evaluation on a child or adolescent with a musculoskeletal complaint (Inpatient or Outpatient)
19. Perform 3 complete written H&P with assessment and review w/ supervisor (Inpatient or Outpatient)
20. Perform 2 well child visits and caregiver counseling: age 12 months to 2 years (Outpatient)
21. Perform 2 well child visits and caregiver counseling: age 2 weeks to 9 months (Outpatient)
22. Perform an evaluation on 2 children or adolescents with a behavioral or developmental concern (Outpatient)
23. Perform an evaluation on 2 children or adolescents with a chronic disease (asthma, CF, seizure disorder, physical disability, etc.) (Inpatient or Outpatient)
24. Plot and interpret growth curves on a CDC growth chart, including BMI on 2 children (Inpatient or Outpatient)
25. Attend Mid Rotation Feedback Session
26. Other Patient Encounters-Pediatrics-Inpatient/Outpatient (6 Required)
27. Other procedures recommended but not required (lumbar puncture, IV placement, urinary catheterization, circumcision)

NPSY G700 Psychiatry/Neurology Clerkship (M3)

1. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with memory loss or other chronic cognitive problem-inpatient or outpatient
2. Perform a complete neurological exam
3. Perform an evaluation on a patient for muscle weakness-outpatient
4. Perform an evaluation on a patient with a movement disorder such as: tremor, chorea, myoclonus, ataxia, ballismus, tic d/o, athetosis or dystonia-inpatient or outpatient
5. Perform an evaluation on a patient with gait disorder and/or dizziness-outpatient
6. Perform an evaluation on a patient with numbness and/or paresthesia-outpatient
7. Observe ECT-inpatient or outpatient
8. Observe an EMG/NCV-inpatient or outpatient
9. Perform interpretation of lesions on a CT or MRI stroke patient-inpatient or outpatient
10. Perform a neurological exam on a patient where the exam is normal-inpatient or outpatient
11. Assist in a neurological exam on an unresponsive patient/coma patient
12. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with mood disorder-inpatient or outpatient
13. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with anxiety spectrum disorder-inpatient or outpatient
14. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with psychotic disorder-inpatient or outpatient
15. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with substance use disorder-inpatient or outpatient
16. Assist in the evaluation of a patient with suicidal presentation-inpatient or outpatient
17. Perform an evaluation on a patient with a headache-inpatient or outpatient
18. Perform an evaluation on a patient with acute stroke/TPA stroke-inpatient or outpatient

19. Perform an evaluation on a patient with a seizure-inpatient or outpatient
20. Assist in the evaluation of two patients with altered mental status
21. Perform two complete history and physicals on a new psychiatric patient-inpatient or outpatient
22. Complete a written History and Physical with the following: An expansive discussion of differential diagnoses on a neuro patient and turn into the Neurology Clerkship Director for grading
23. Complete a written History and Physical with the following: An expansive discussion of differential diagnoses on a psych patient and turn into the Psychiatry Clerkship Director for grading
24. Other patient encounters (6)
25. Present a formal presentation (5-10 minutes) on a neurologic topic during morning report-inpatient or outpatient
26. Attend an AA meeting and turn in a one page summary of your experience to the clerkship coordinator
27. Attend a Psychiatric Grand Rounds
28. Complete NIH Stroke Scale training prior to the start of the clerkship and turn in your certificate of completion
29. Attend mid-point feedback session

SURG G700 Surgery Clerkship (M3)

1. Perform Foley Catheter Placement in a Female Patient (in- or out-patient/ED)
2. Perform Foley Catheter Placement in a Male Patient (in- or out-patient/ED)
3. Perform intravenous line placement (in- or out-patient/ED)
4. Observe or perform Central Venous Catheter placement (in- or out-patient/ED)
5. Perform an Arterial Blood Gas (in- or out-patient/ED)
6. Perform naso- or orogastric tube placement (in- or out-patient/ED)
7. Perform an H&P under direct supervision during the second half of the clerkship (in- or out-patient)
8. Perform wound management techniques/dressing changes on an inpatient
9. Perform FAST exam (ED)
10. Perform a preoperative assessment and write Pre-op orders (inpatient)
11. Perform a postoperative assessment/post-op check (inpatient)
12. Write admission or postoperative orders (inpatient)
13. Perform an evaluation on a patient with an acute surgical abdomen (inpatient or ED)
14. Perform an evaluation on a patient with a groin hernia (inpatient or outpatient)
15. Assist in the evaluation of an acute trauma patient for surgical intervention (ED)
16. Observe at least 3 different types of the following surgical procedures: pulmonary, esophageal, cardiac, abdominal, breast, vascular
17. Perform an evaluation on a patient with gallbladder/biliary stone disease
18. Perform a complete history & physical examination on an in- or out-patient
19. Complete six other patient encounters (in- or outpatient)
20. Complete Nutrition Assessment Case Study
21. Attend mid-rotation feedback session
