

Exposure at

home/school/hospital/community to a COVID-19 positive person

- Persons under investigation (PUI) for COVID-19 lives within their household.
- Close contact with positive COVID-19 people [closer than 6ft. WITHOUT proper PPE.
- Close contact with positive COVID-19 people [closer than 6ft >15min WITH mask in place.]

IF mask was worn by student AND COVID-19 positive person, no exposure occurred

Asymptomatic: *Follow school guidelines at all times

UH requires you to mask around others continuously, OK to return to clinical, record daily temp & symptoms for 14 days & submit to school for clearance **Symptomatic**: Stay home until cleared by MD and/or school to return to clinical.

(fever/chills, cough, short of breath, fatigue, body aches, headache, loss of taste/smell, sore throat, congestion/runny nose, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea)

Students must provide proof of a negative COVID-19 test to the school prior to returning to clinical.

Students who test positive for COVID-19

Notify school immediately.

Submit a return-to-work document to school before returning to clinical.
